Status of policies and other written control documents

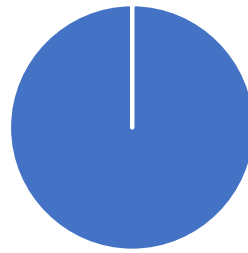
There are 2 policies on the policy register, which were approved by the Knowledge, Research and Information Committee (KRIC) or have been delegated to the Committee by the Board.
