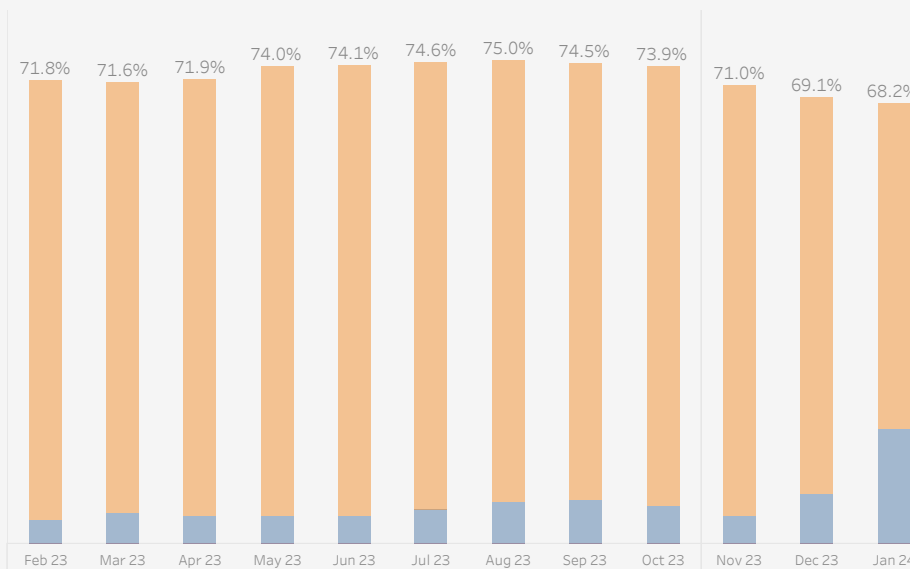

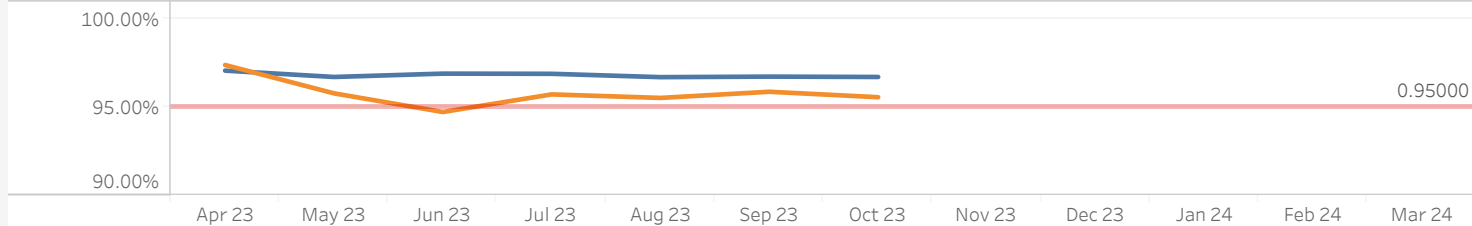

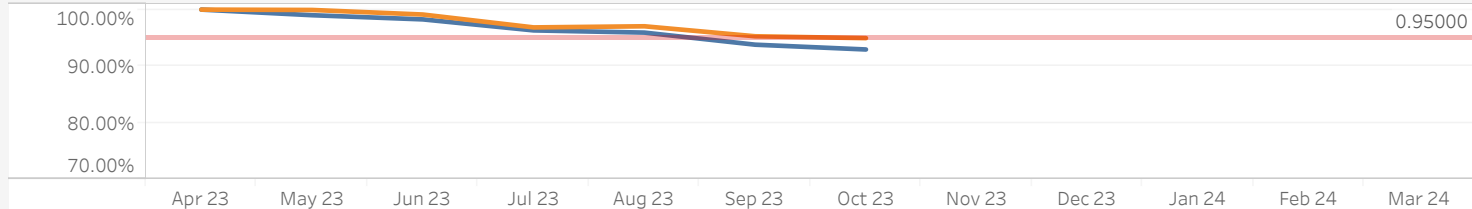

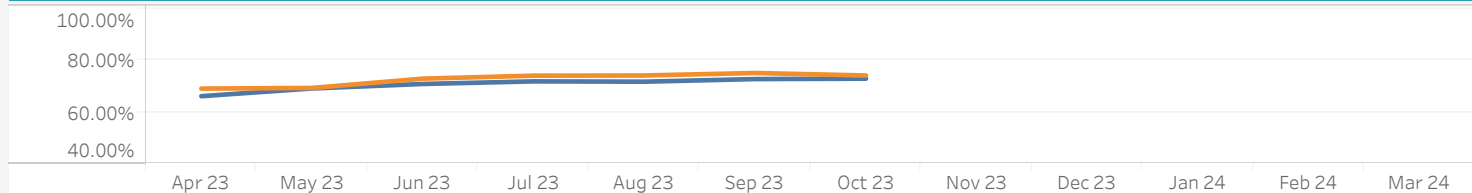

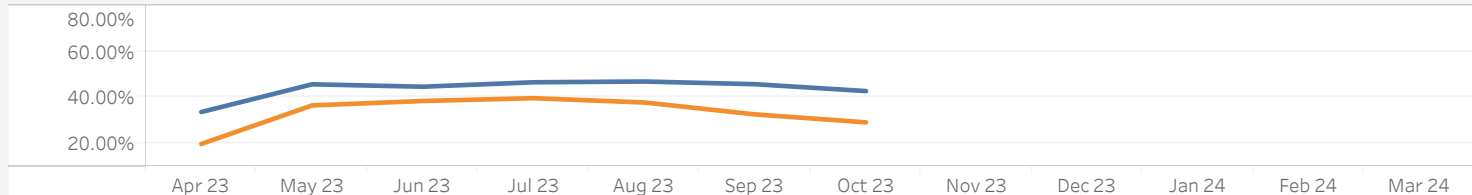

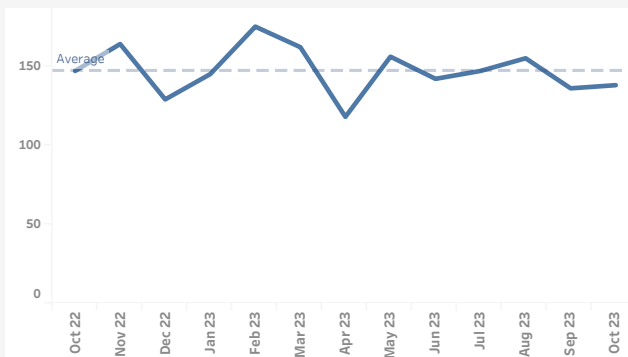

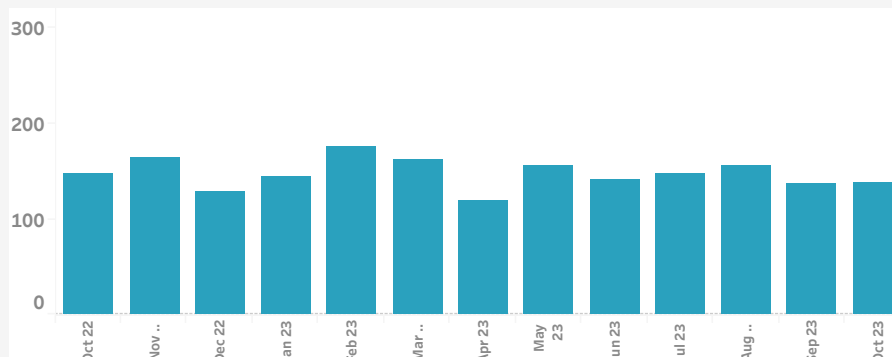

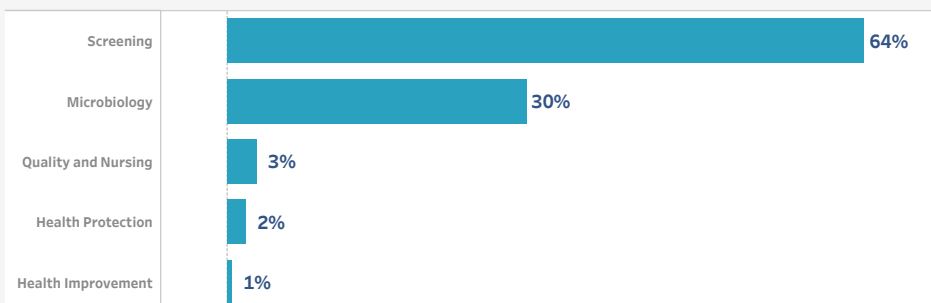

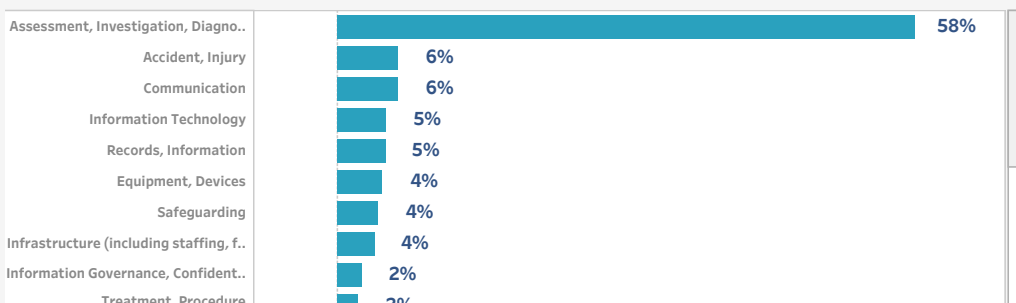
Incidents Overtime Split by Status: Ongoing vs Closed



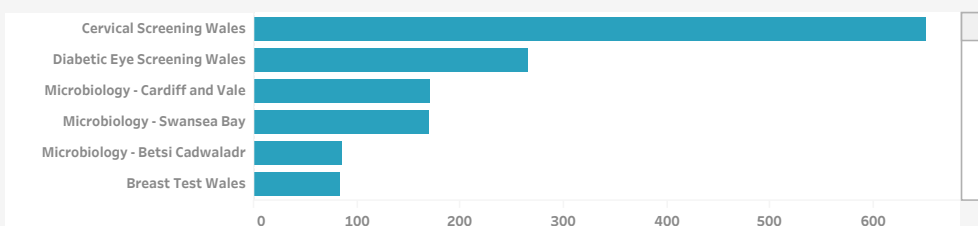

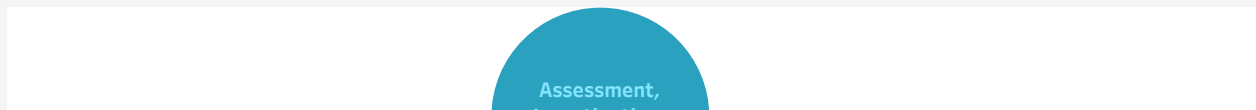

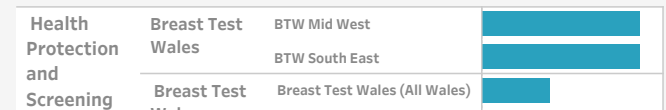

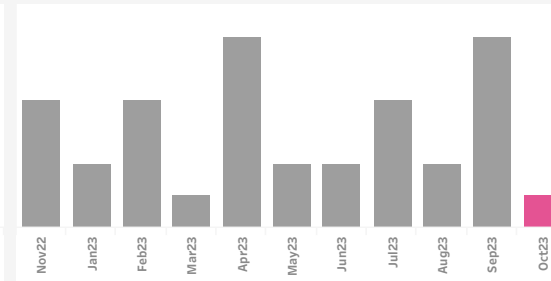

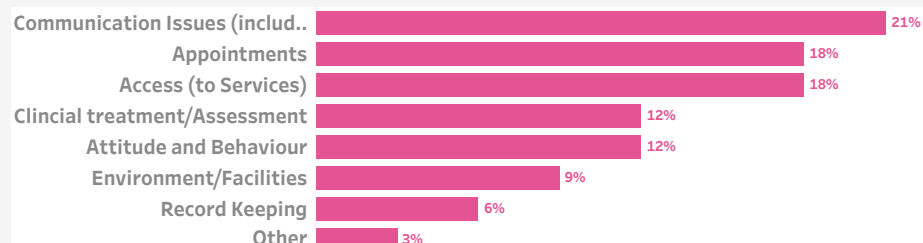
Formal Complaints raised by Month



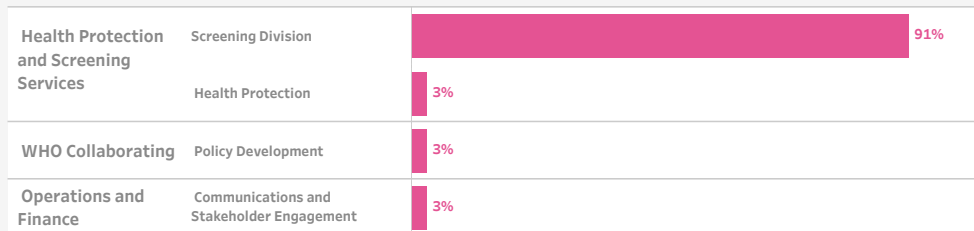

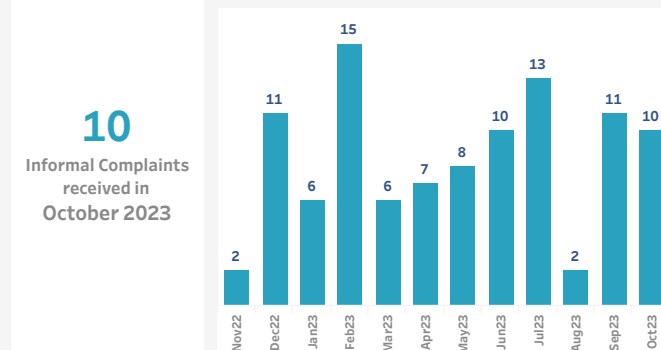

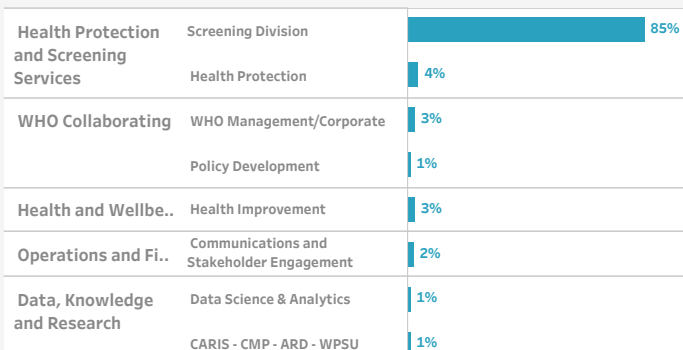

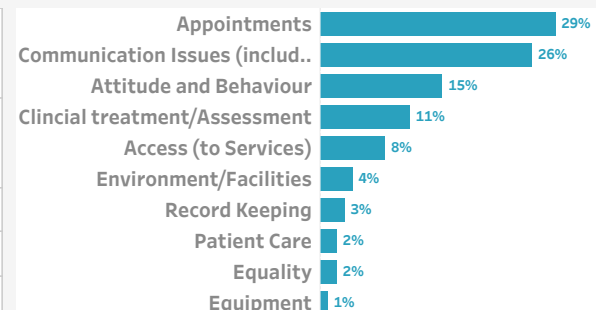
